

TRAINING - CRIMINAL JUSTICE REFORMS

In October 2017 the NSW Government passed a range of legislation to reform the criminal justice system. The changes are substantial and include:

- 1. Encouraging early appropriate guilty pleas ('EAGP')
- 2. Sentencing reforms
- 3. Parole reforms
- 4. Reforms to the management of high risk sex and violent offenders
