The Hon Murray Gleeson AC QC will give the inaugural Bathurst Lecture, named in honour of the current Chief Justice of New South Wales, the Hon T F Bathurst AC.

The Bathurst Lecture is held on an annual basis by the Commercial Law Section of the New South Wales Bar and features a distinguished speaker giving a paper on a topic of interest to commercial barristers.

Murray Gleeson was Chief Justice of New South Wales from 1988 to 1998 and Chief Justice of Australia from 1998 to 2008. Before that he was member of the New South Wales bar, taking silk in 1974 and becoming President of the Bar Association in 1984 to 1985. He is presently a Non Permanent Judge of the Hong Kong Final Court of Appeal and Patron of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators (Australia).
