General federal law cases can now be conducted in the Parramatta registry of the Federal Circuit Court of Australia

The Federal Circuit Court of Australia has announced that it will commence a *General Federal Law* list in the Parramatta registry from 1 January 2019.

All of these matters will be docketed to Judge Obradovic who will conduct between 8-10 weeks of sittings to hear general federal law cases in Parramatta.

Filing

There will be no changes to the existing practice of filing all general federal law matters in the Sydney registry (Queens Square).

Allocation of matters to Parramatta

A limited number of matters with an address for service of the applicant (whether represented or unrepresented) that is closer in geographical proximity to the Parramatta Registry than to the Sydney Registry will be allocated to the Parramatta list.

It is anticipated that matters such as migration, industrial and human rights cases will form part of this list.
