Members are invited to compete in the 31st GBBR in a friendly competition with solicitors. This is a non-spinnaker race for monohull keelboats > 6.5m.

The Organising Authority is the RAN Sailing Association ("RANSA").

Start Time: 11:00 am on Monday, 22 December 2014

Start Line: Vicinity Shark Island/Point Piper

Course: Final details will be provided in Sailing Instructions (about 2 ½ hours race)

Finish: Store Beach

Post-race Activities: (i) Picnic on Store Beach (ii) Presentation of trophies on Store Beach

Entry Fee per Boat: \$190.00

Any money raised from the race will be donated to the Barristers' Benevolent Fund.

- Sailing Instructions will be provided to all confirmed and accepted entrants on Thursday, 18 December 2014. Entries close noon 16 December. Any entries considered after that date will have a worse handicap.

The Bar Association's current insurance policy does not cover this activity. <u>IT IS A STRICT CONDITION OF ENTRY</u> that all skippers have arranged appropriate third party, property and personal injury insurance, to cover themselves, their crew and their guests for the duration of the event. No boats will be entered into the race until a copy of the certificate is sent to the organizing authority, RAN Sailing Association.

All participants are required to sign the indemnity incorporated in the entry form in order to compete in the race.
