Emeritus Professor Gillian Triggs is the President of the Australian Human Rights Commission. She was Dean of the Faculty of Law and Challis Professor of International Law at the University of Sydney from 2007 to 2012. She is a former barrister with Seven Wentworth Chambers. Professor Elizabeth Elliott is Professor of Paediatrics and Child Health at the Sydney Medical School, University of Sydney and a Consultant Paediatrician at the Sydney Children's Hospitals Network (Westmead). She was a medical consultant to the Australian Human Rights Commission Inquiry into children in immigration detention and visited Christmas Island with Professor Triggs in July 2014.
