John Sturrock QC received Honours and Master's degrees in law from the Universities of Edinburgh and Pennsylvania and was admitted to the Scottish Bar in 1986. He had a very busy civil practice and from 1994 to 2002 was the first Director of Training and Education in the Faculty of Advocates where he designed and led the Scottish Bar's award-winning advocacy skills programme. John was appointed Queen's Counsel in 1999. He left practice in 2002 to establish Core. He trained in negotiation at Harvard University and was named Specialist of the Year at the Scottish Legal Awards in 2003 and Mediator of the Year at the Law Awards of Scotland in 2009. He was awarded the Honorary Degree of Doctor of Laws from Edinburgh Napier University in 2010.

An internationally recognised coach and facilitator on the fields of negotiation, mediation, collaboration and communication, John has worked with business leaders, senior executives and managers, judges and top athletes and with senior politicians and civil servants in ground-breaking training in UK parliaments and assemblies. He has also been described as "one of the best teachers of mediation".
