IJM is a global team of lawyers, investigators, social workers, community activists and other professionals at work in nearly 20 communities in the developing world to protect the poor from violence.

Inspired by God's call to love all people and to seek justice for the oppressed, IJM protects the poor from violence, irrespective of race, religion or any other factor, and seeks to work alongside all people of goodwill.

IJM's philosophy is simple:

When public justice systems are made to protect the poor - and slave owners, traffickers and other criminals can no longer act with impunity - millions of vulnerable men, women and children will never be abused.
