



EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

NSW BAR ASSOCIATION'S FAMILY LAW MEDIATORS & FDRP's LIST

(Formerly the Family Law Settlement Services Panel – Barristers)

The New South Wales Bar Association (the Association) was in the process of reviewing all alternative dispute resolution lists maintained by the Association this year before the COVID-19 pandemic hit, to ensure their integrity and best placement to promote ongoing opportunities for our practitioners. While the lists and their criteria remain subject to ongoing review by relevant Committees, the Association appreciates that the pandemic and its impacts are unprecedented. In response, to support members' practices at this time, the Association has temporarily opened and is inviting Expressions of Interest for its Family Law Mediators and FDRP's List (formerly the Family Law Settlement Services Panel - Barristers). If you are already a member of this list, there is no need to re-apply.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, applicants must:

- 1. Hold accreditation as either:
 - a. a mediator with the Association under the National Mediation Accreditation System; and/or
 - b. a Family Dispute Resolution Practitioner under the Family Law Act 1975 (Cth); and
- 2. Hold a current practising certificate with the Association; and
- 3. Have demonstrated substantial involvement in the area of family law in the three years prior to this application; and
- 4. Have demonstrated that the time devoted to this area of practice, in each year of the past three years, is not less than 25% of normal full-time practice.

If an applicant is unable to meet the above criteria (for example, through illness or parental leave), they may still be eligible for inclusion if they can demonstrate relevant family law mediation and litigation experience.

The names, chambers and contact details of successful applicants will be included on the *Family Law Mediators and FDRP's List*, which will be displayed on the Association's website and regularly provided to the Family Court of Australia and Federal Circuit Court of Australia (**the Courts**). If at any time a barrister ceases to hold a Practising Certificate, relevant insurance or accreditation, their eligibility for inclusion on the *Family Law Mediators and FDRP's List* will automatically cease and their name will be removed from the list.
