CHIEF MAGISTRATE'S MEMORANDUM NO. 16 COVID-19

ARRANGEMENTS FOR LOCAL COURT PROCEEDINGS –Greater Metropolitan Area.

In response to the [NSW Public Health \(COVID-19 Mandatory Face Coverings\) Order](#) 2021 the following protocol applies to the Greater Sydney Region.

For the **period of the above public health order** the following arrangements are to apply to the following Local Courts:

Masks (Fitted Face coverings)

Masks should be worn in all public corridors and waiting areas within the above courts.

Everyone in a courtroom is strongly encouraged to wear a mask, unless:

- a) The person concerned is an active participant in the proceedings namely the presiding judicial officer, a legal representative who is responsible for presenting the case, an unrepresented party or a witness giving evidence.
- b) one of the exemptions stated in the Public Health (COVID-19 Mandatory Face Coverings) Order 2021 applies; or
- c) at the discretion of the presiding judicial officer.
