## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to ensure that accused detainees held in custody at the Newcastle Justice Precinct are not required to appear physically before a court in bail proceedings.

This Regulation is made under the *Evidence (Audio and Audio Visual Links) Act 1998*, including sections 5BA (2) (e) and 22 (1) (the general regulation-making power).
