The Attorney General is seeking applications from qualified persons for appointment as Crown Prosecutors under the *Crown Prosecutors Act 1986* for a fixed term of up to seven years that may be renewed, following an initial twelve-month probationary period.

Crown Prosecutors represent the Director of Public Prosecutions in providing an independent, efficient, fair and just prosecution service for the people of New South Wales. They provide high-level, independent professional representation and advice as counsel representing the Director in criminal matters in all criminal courts.

Positions will be available in Sydney and other locations around the State and may include primarily appellate roles. Successful applicants may be required to attend regional courts as directed.

Applicants must be Australian lawyers. The key skills and knowledge required for the role are outlined in the online role description and must be addressed in the online application. In particular, applicants should outline their experience in conducting complex jury trials and/or criminal appeals.
