

Deputy Director of Public Prosecutions

The Attorney General is seeking applications from qualified persons for appointment as a Deputy Director of Public Prosecutions under the *Director of Public Prosecutions Act 1986* for a fixed term that may be renewed.

The role of Deputy Director of Public Prosecutions is to provide advice to the Director of Public Prosecutions (DPP); appear in the High Court and the Supreme Court on more complex and sensitive appeals; review recommendations by and direct Crown Prosecutors and lawyers of the Office of the DPP (ODPP) on various matters; assist in the management of the ODPP; contribute to the professional development of ODPP Legal Staff; and perform the functions of the DPP as delegated.
