Independent Commission Against Corruption

The NSW Government is seeking to appoint a full-time Chief Commissioner and two part-time Commissioners to the Independent Commission Against Corruption (ICAC).

The ICAC provides for the independent investigation, exposure and prevention of corrupt conduct within the NSW public sector. The ICAC also educates public authorities, public officials and members of the public about corruption and its detrimental effects. The ICAC is a three-member Commission, comprising a full-time Chief Commissioner and two part-time Commissioners.

The Chief Commissioner and Commissioners will have a well-developed understanding of anti-corruption and integrity principles, issues and current trends, particularly relating to public sector conduct. The successful applicant will also have demonstrated ability to judiciously use wide ranging oversight and investigatory powers.

To be considered for the role of Chief Commissioner or Commissioner, candidates must be qualified to be appointed as, or must have previously been, a Judge of the Supreme Court of NSW (or another State or Territory), a Judge of the Federal Court of Australia or a Justice of the High Court of Australia. Current judicial officers from NSW or elsewhere in Australia are not eligible for appointment.

High quality candidates for each of the roles will have outstanding leadership skills and experience at a senior level within the legal profession. The ability to lead an organisation and inspire their team is critical. They will have strong consultation experience and exceptional negotiation and communications skills.

The successful applicants will be individuals of the highest ethical standards with a commitment to integrity in government.

The appointments will be for a term of up to five years. Remuneration details are provided in the Role Description.
