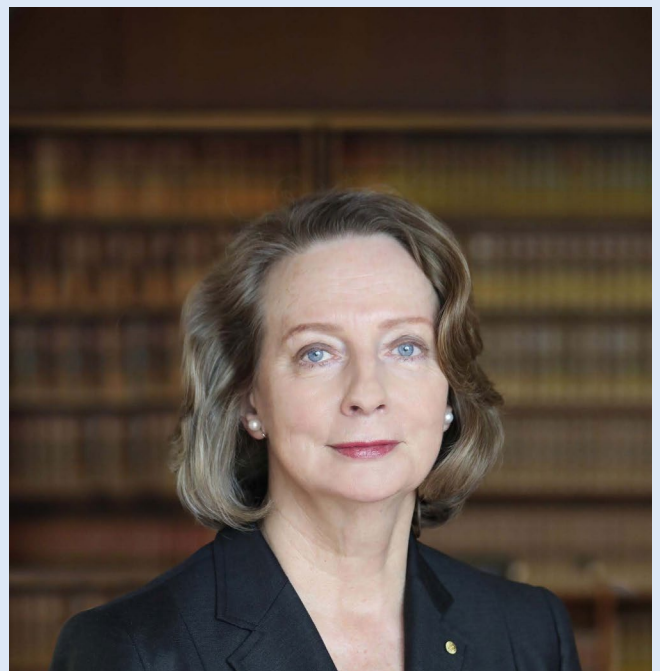
The Honourable Susan Kiefel was appointed Chief Justice of the High Court of Australia on 30 January 2017, having served as a Justice of the High Court since 3 September 2007.

Her Honour was educated in Queensland and at the University of Cambridge, where she received a Master of Law. Having been admitted to the Queensland Bar in 1975, in 1987 her Honour became the first woman in Queensland to be appointed Queen's Counsel. She became a Justice of the Supreme Court of Queensland in 1993, and a Justice of the Federal Court in 1994.

Her Honour was made a Companion in the General Division of the Order of Australia in 2011.

Her Honour is the Patron of the Australian Academy of Law and of the Australasian Institute of Judicial Administration.
