Election of Members of Bar Council for 2024

The ballot for the 2024 Bar Council opens at **9.00am on Thursday, 19 October 2023** and closes at **1.00pm on Thursday, 2 November 2023**.

You may vote by either:

- completing and returning a hardcopy ballot paper; OR
- casting your vote electronically via the Association's online election platform

You may only vote once. If you return a paper ballot and submit a vote online, only one vote will be counted and the Returning Officer will determine which vote will be counted.

Ballot papers for the election of the 2024 Bar Council are being mailed to all those eligible to vote.

All voting members, with the exception of those who have elected not to receive email communications from the Association should receive a link via email to the electronic platform on Thursday, 19 October 2023. If you have not received the email by COB Thursday, 19 October 2023, please contact elections@nswbar.asn.au.

Any member who has not received their paper ballot by COB Thursday, 26 October 2023, and who wishes to cast a vote, should contact the Association's Project and Administrative Officer at elections@nswbar.asn.au.

Any member intending to vote using the paper ballot should be aware of the [Australia Post guidance on Delivery speeds and coverage](#). Regular letters posted within NSW can take up to 4 business days to arrive. Ballots can be dropped at the Bar Association into the ballot box at reception during business hours.

Members should take care to complete the ballot paper in accordance with the instructions provided. If any member has a query concerning the completion of the ballot paper, they should contact the Bar Association for assistance.

The ballot closes at **1.00pm on Thursday, 2 November 2023**. Any ballot received after 1.00pm on Thursday, 2 November 2023 cannot be counted.
