Efiling via the Online Registry:

- Documents must be filed via the <u>Online Registry</u>.
- See <u>list of forms</u> that can be lodged via the online registry.

Email Filing (PDF documents only)

- Use sc.emailfiling@justice.nsw.gov.au
- Email filing is accepted for any document that is not available for filing via the Online registry.
- Each type of document must be a separate attachment eg. Summons for leave, Notice of Appeal.
- An invoice will be issued via a payment link for fee attracting documents, except in some situations.
- Your document will not be actioned until the fee is paid.
- If it is not feasible to file online or via e-mail filing, you must post original documents to the Court.
- Documents maybe rejected if the form can be lodged using the online registry & a fee levied.

Costs Assessment:

- Online filing is not available for Costs Assessment applications.
