

The Rules



Entry Fee

\$30 once off contribution. This, or a legally enforceable non-negotiable bill of exchange ('IOU') must be received with your first round tips which are due before 4am on 8 June 2019 (ie before kick-off of the first game). Any IOU must be paid by 11 June 2019.

Prize pool distribution

60% to the winner, 30% to second place, 10% to third placeⁱ but 2/3rds of those prizes will be donated (on the prize-winner's behalf) to the prize-winner's nominated charity. In other words, 2/3rds of the money raised will go to charity.

Tips

The form you must complete for the first round follows. Failure to tip any particular game or special category will not disqualify you, it will just reduce your chance of winning.

We will only receive electronic copies of the document completed on screen and returned by reply email (to Mark's address). The document is set up so you can 'tab' through to each field. The forms for the second and subsequent rounds will be sent by email and must be returned by reply email. Telephone tips will not be accepted.

First Round Tipping Form

These tips must be in before **4am AEST 8 June 2019**

You cannot tip this round in parts, the whole of this form (including the bonus point questions at the end of this form) must be made at the one time. Tipping forms for the later rounds will be emailed to you.

First Round Games

To complete this part of the form, type into the middle columns the score that you tip. You will get 2 points for tipping the correct result (ie the winner or a draw) and 0.5 bonus points for tipping the correct score.

For example if you tip "France 3 1 Korea Rep" you are tipping France to win 3-1. If France won 3-0 you would get 2 points for the correct result, but not the bonus 0.5 point for the correct score. If the actual result was Korea Rep winning 3-1 you get no points – you would not get the bonus point for tipping the correct score (even though you tipped a 3-1 result).

As a further example, if you tip "France 1 1 Korea Rep" you are tipping a 1-1 draw. If the result is 2-2 then you again would get 2 points for the correct result (a draw) but not the bonus 0.5 point for the correct score.

1. For 2 bonus points each, based *only on the first round games*, please type the *team* that:

2. For 3 bonus points each, please type the name of the player who will:

Score the most goals in the whole tournament (ie the winner of the 'golden boot')	
Be named by FIFA as the player of the tournament (ie the winner of the 'golden ball')

Later Rounds

Tipping forms for the second and subsequent rounds will be emailed to you. Because of the close proximity of the rounds you will have to have tips in quickly.

In the later rounds, you will get **2 points** for the correct outcome before penalties, (team A wins, team B wins or a draw), **1 bonus point** for tipping the correct score (before penalty shootout), plus **2 points** for picking correctly the team that goes through.

For these later rounds we will send emails to you, you must meet the deadline AEST outlined in the email for your tips to be valid.

If you 'forget to tip' any of the above five tipping rounds you will be awarded for that round 1 point less than the lowest tipped score for that round.



¹ Prize pool distribution where more than one person ties for one or more of the first 3 places is as follows (note: in each case 2/3rds of all winnings are donated to each prize-winner's nominated charity in the prize-winner's name). Where:

- 2 people are equal first, then they get 90% of the prize pool each, and 10% of the pool goes to the next highest score, and if more than one person has the next highest score, that 10% is divided equally amongst them;
- more than 2 people are equal first, then 100% of the prize pool is divided equally amongst them, with no other prizes awarded;
- there is 1 winner, and 2 or more people on the next highest score, then the winner gets 60%, and those on the next highest score share equally 40% and no other prizes are awarded;
- there is 1 winner, 1 in second place, and more than 1 person in equal third place, then the prizes are divided, 60% to 1st place, 30% to 2nd place, and the remaining 10% divided equally amongst those in equal third place.
